

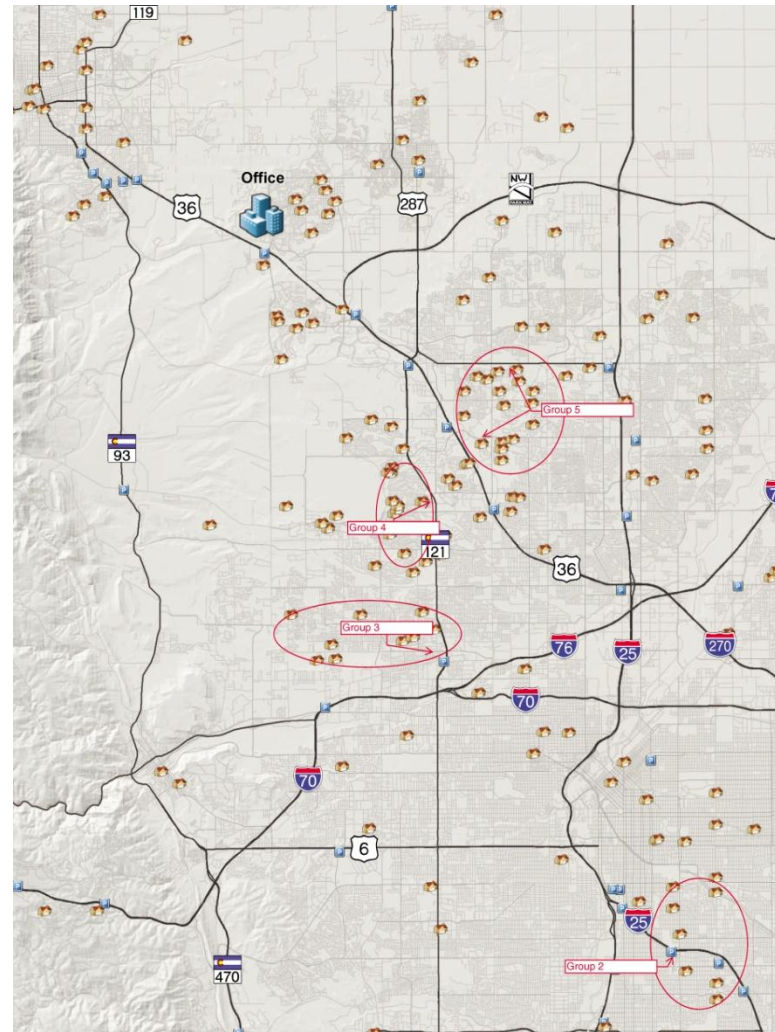

DOT MAP

- A dot map is a wonderful visual tool, helping employees to identify carpooling and vanpooling opportunities.
- A dot map can be used for vanpool matching.
- To create a dot map:
 - Submit a list of employee addresses (no names) in Excel to 36 Commuting Solutions.
 - Employees from specific departments or groups that have different work hours can be identified on the map.

Planning your business and holiday travel is easy using RTD SkyRide, which provides a direct connection to Denver International Airport (DIA). Sky Ride offers frequent, all-day service, giving you a way to skip the drive to (and parking expenses of) DIA.

RTD's SkyRide service offers a direct connection to DIA from many different Park-n-Rides across the Denver metro, including most Park-n-Rides along U.S. 36 (U.S. 36 is served by the AB SkyRide Route). SkyRide operators will help you stow your luggage in compartments beneath the coach, and, once aboard, you will travel in ease to DIA, where the SkyRide stops curbside at Level 5.

SkyRide arrives at, and departs from, select RTD Park-n-Rides at pre-scheduled times, and different SkyRide routes service different areas of the Denver metro...
